#### Conference:

Next year's conference will take place on the third Saturday of the month, February 15, 2020. The theme will be Avocational Archaeology. A potential keynote could be Jodi Barnes, who is familiar with the avocational training program in Arkansas, or a panel of professionals and avocationals who could provide differing perspectives about doing archaeology and working together. Potential panel participants could be Jodi, Al Goodyear, Lamar Nelson, Tommy Charles. Keith will contact Jodi.

We need to talk to Savannah about getting the room in Gambrell reserved.

A call for papers needs to go out ASAP. As well as a call for nominations for the annual awards. A Facebook event should also be created.

We should tentatively stick with the same conference schedule as last year, from 9 to 5. Like last year, the keynote should speak before lunch, which worked really well.

David Jones has just retired from the Park Service, and Becca and Stacey have talked about holding an after conference event for his retirement.

## Fall Field Day:

Took place on October 26, 2019 and will again be at the 12,000 Year History Park in Cayce. We spent around \$4,000 total on FFD this year, which is much higher than normal. We need to be better about making and budget and sticking to it and pursuing sponsorships to help fund the event. We could also consider bringing back the auction as a way to raise money for the event.

We had slightly less attendance than last year, but it was still well attended. Some thoughts of next year include trying to diversify some of our demonstrators so we aren't offering the only the same content every year, this seems to have cut attendance down. We should also just consider holding FFD during a football weekend. We usually try to avoid it, but so do other events in town. This year there were multiple other events happening on the same day, like the Chili Cook Off and the Korean Festival, which could have also cut down on attendance. October 24 could be a potential date.

A colleague of Chris Judge spoke to Becca during the event and suggested that next year we partner with a Powwow event that will be held for Native American Heritage Month, which typically occurs in November. As many of the same people would be interested in both of our events, it was suggested that we partner instead of competing with each other. Becca will contact Chris Judge to get more information and try to set up the connections to potentially make this happen. We may have to change the venue if we partner with the Powwow, since the 12,000 Year History Park is not a huge space.
